Fat injection is a procedure designed to remove fat from one area of the body and transfer it to another area of the body. The fat is harvested with a needle under local anesthesia and is reinjected through a syringe and needle. Common problems which may be associated with this are reabsorption of the fat with subsequent loss of the contour improvement. With any surgical procedure, bleeding and infection can be problems. Other less likely complications are deformity at the donor site and small scars resulting from the injection and harvesting.
